In case you were not able to attend, here are the things we celebrated and announced.

Celebrations

-A successfully smooth transition between the previous Executive Director of 5 years, Zak Caldwell, and our new Executive Director, Zach Lewis. We were able to maintain a good number of students and donors/supporters.

-A very successful Thanksgiving meal, where we were able to provide food and community for over 30 teens in Jefferson County.

-During our Year-End Campaign we were given a matching gift of \$3,000, which we met. Altogether, you helped to raise nearly \$10,000 to help improve our programs, send kids to camps & trips, and to gain additional resources. This gives us hope that we can reach the goals we set for ourselves to grow our ministry.

Announcements

-As a chapter we set forth a goal for ourselves for the next fiver years, which is to grow the amount of ministries we offer. These ministries would include: Parent Life (working with teen moms and dads), YFC Core (working in middle & high schools with our believing students on how to reach their schools), Juvenile Justice Ministry (working with teens in detention centers), and expanding the number of City Life & Campus Life programs throughout Crooks, Deschutes, & Jefferson County.

-Jonathan VanVliet has come on board as a volunteer staff member to start a Juvenile Justice Ministry (JJM) in Bend. Both the ministry and location are brand new things for us.

There was so much more beyond this snapshot, and I am excited for all of it. I believe the Father is at work and is moving within YFC to reach Central Oregon. Join with us in prayer, support, and volunteering as we pursue the vision given to us.
